



## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

In order for all Scouts visiting Kandersteg International Scout Centre to have a great stay there are some rules & regulations which we need to make you aware of.

These General Rules & Regulations form an integral part of the Terms & Conditions which you accept by signing the Booking Form before or on arrival.

### **General Rules**

#### **Quiet Time**

We are required to abide by the village law, which states that between 22:30 and 07:30 it is quiet time around the village and thus at the Centre as well. Please keep noise to an absolute minimum during these times.

#### **Smoking**

Smoking is not allowed inside any of the buildings or campsite shelters. We have designated smoking areas out on the terrace so please make use of them. In the Chalet, Kander-Lodge, Sunneblick and Tower candles or other naked flames are not allowed. Candles and/or fires (only in fire places in Chalet Main Hall, High Adventure Room, Sunneblick hall stove or Tower Hall) are allowed with permission from Staff and must be kept under supervision.

#### **Fire Regulations**

The Chalet, Kander-Lodge, Sunneblick and Tower are equipped with sophisticated fire alarm systems and clearly marked emergency exits. Spraying aerosols into the detectors or removing the detectors, blocking emergency exits, blocking the automatic fire doors or blocking the emergency lights is forbidden. If you are found doing any of the above you will have to leave KISC immediately and will have to deal with legal action in the civil court.

In the event the Fire Brigade are called due to a false fire alarm which is caused by you or your group you will be charged a fee of CHF 600.-

#### **Fireworks**

Fireworks are strictly forbidden anywhere on KISC property and will be confiscated if found.

#### **Alcohol**

Alcohol should not be seen on KISC premises. Alcohol should be kept within your Campsite, Room or other private area. Exceptions to this can be made by the General Director, Operational Director or Deputy Directors, on special request or for special events. For alcohol we follow and comply with Swiss law. Your internal rules will be respected as long as they do not conflict with Swiss law.

#### **Forbidden Areas**

It is forbidden to enter the **Railway Line** for any reason.

It is forbidden to enter the **Nature Reserve (Fillfalle)** except on the designated paths.

It is forbidden to climb the **East Wall** (campsite). This area is prone to rock fall and is a restricted military zone.

#### **Fires, Pits & Trenches**

Please note that the digging of trenches and lighting of ground fires is strictly forbidden. Fire can be made in our fire barrels or on any other construction as long as they are off the ground. Fire barrels are provided free of charge.

#### **Theft**

Stealing property including flags from KISC, other groups staying at KISC or from others in the village is not acceptable and is a criminal offence in Switzerland and will be dealt with accordingly.
